For 2013 there were 140 calls to Bass River Township; Squad 85 responded to 100 of the calls and other responders to the other 40 calls. In July of 2013..squad 85 responded to 11 calls and Quality responded to 8 and Galloway responded to 2.

Contract would have to be drawn up if the Township were to go to a paid service.

The consensus of the audience was for the short term Quality would be the primary and fund volunteer squad locally with the aim toward local paid squad.
