RESOLUTION 2015-50

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BASS RIVER, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AN ADDENDUM TO THE CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN ATHLETIC COURTS, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE MUNICIPAL PARK TENNIS COURT

WHEREAS, a contract was previously awarded American Athletic Courts, Inc. for construction of the Municipal Park Tennis Court; and

WHEREAS, the original contract for said work was in the amount of \$73,500.00: and

WHEREAS, the original contract price has been adjusted to \$80,325.00: and

WHEREAS, the governing body wishes to authorize Change Order No. 1, which will result in a increase of \$6,825.00 in the adjusted contract price, consisting of those items set forth on Schedule "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof: and

WHEREAS, this change order has been recommended by the Municipal Engineer and agreed to by the contractor; and

WHEREAS, this change order, together with all previous change orders, amounts to a total of less than twenty (20%) percent of the original contract awarded to the contractor; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing body to authorize this change order.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Township of Bass River, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That the governing body does hereby authorize the execution of an addendum to the contract for the construction of the Municipal Park Tennis Court with American Athletic Courts, Inc., to provide for a increase in the adjusted contract price from \$73,500.00 to \$80,325.00, an increase of \$6,825.00 in the adjusted contract price, consisting of those items set forth on Schedule "A", attached hereto and made part hereof.
- 2. That the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an addendum to the contract with American Athletic Courts, Inc in accordance with the provisions of this resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-52

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, there exists a need for the services of a law firm to serve as In Rem Counsel for the Township of Bass River; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts law <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-1 et seq. requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contract for "professional services" without competitive bids and the resulting contract must be available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts law further requires that a Notice of the award of the contract be printed as a legal advertisement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Township of Bass River this 1st day of June, 2015, as follows:

1. The law firm Goldberg, Mackler of Northfield, New Jersey be and the same is hereby appointed as Counsel for the Township of Bass River with respect to the In Rem Foreclosure.

2. This contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "professional service" in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-5(1)(a) of the Local Public Contracts Law because said contract encompasses a professional service recognized and regulated by law.

3. The Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Agreement with Keith Bonchi, Esq. of Goldberg, Mackler.

4. Notice of this action shall be published once as a legal advertisement in the official newspaper of the Township of Bass River within ten days of its adoption.

OLD BUSINESS:

Discussion concerning Block 43 Lot 6 and the offer made for assignment of tax sale certificate. Originally offer was turned down by the Board because assess value of property was in access of \$50,000. Upon further research it was found the lot is not a buildable piece of property and attaches to the bidder's property and is land locked otherwise. Assessment is not correct and must be changed. Furthermore accepting the bid made by Ruffo for less than amount owed will require future advertising and resolution to accept offer at next meeting. Agreed by board to move forward with acceptance of Ruffo bid on Block 43, Lot 6.

Discussion concerning Block 103, Lot 177 and bed by Vogel. Mayor will need to consult tax assessor and discuss regarding PDC's. Property is assessed at \$70,900.00 for 41.7 acres in preservation zone. Further research on parcel will be needed to determine what course to take for the best interest of the Township.

NEW BUSINESS:

Brian Cowperthwait and Joe Capriglione spoke on behalf of New Jersey Disaster Relief a nonprofit organization with ideas for emergency services and community outreach program for Bass River Township. The group is requesting residency at the shop at 42 East Greenbush Road in attempt to get funding for insurance coverage for the group. Mayor and Commissioner have requested more information on the group and Solicitor to seek information from DCA to determine if the Township can assist legally.
