

RESOLUTION #3 OF 2023 - 39

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BASS RIVER, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FOR GYPSY MOTH SUPPRESSION

WHEREAS, the Gypsy Moth *Lymantria dispar, dispar (LDD)* has been found heavily defoliating tree and plant growth in the Township of Bass River; and

WHEREAS, continued destruction of foliage may result in loss of valuable forestlands and trees: and

WHEREAS, The Commissioners of the Township of Bass River have determined that a Gypsy Moth control program be instituted with the State of New Jersey Department of Agriculture and that the application for any Federal or State funds available be authorized.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Township of Bass River that the gypsy moth is declared a to be a public nuisance and the protection of vegetation of plant life therefrom is deemed to be a subject matter of public welfare, and that all measures deemed necessary, in compliance with the State of New Jersey Department of Agriculture recommendations, is hereby authorized to suppress this forest and shade tree pest.
