<u>Old Business:</u> Board discussion zoning changes including Engineer's revised zoning ordinance and zoning map.

7:10 PM Engineer Dan Guzzi began explaining the newest changes.

Little Egg Harbor construction office has asked us to compile guidelines for accessory structures. Suggestions were-

- It should be based on the lot size.
- Under 2 acres lot would have a size limit
- If a large shed, it would have to meet principle dwelling setbacks
- Grandfather clause follow same footprint

Fencing: Setbacks will be 6" off the property line- side and rear. Front fence must be open style and a height restriction of 12'.

Corner – nothing in sight triangle. No more than 3' into the setbacks.

Dirt/Fill: Limits on removal. Dirt should be tested. Should be amount limits due to lost size of what can be brought in.

Engineer Dan Guzzi is going to incorporate the updates into the zoning ordinance and email us the updates.

<u>**7:50PM**</u> Meeting open to the public after a motion by Mrs. Cope – seconded by Mr. Bourguignon. All were in favor.

A member of the public was on this call and wanted information about the "car sales" at the gas station formerly known as Bernie's. She was told that code enforcement had told them they could not operate as car sales and that the sign had to come down also. She was happy to hear this.
